Zıplamanın tekrar eden iniş çıkış hareketi eserin temel ritmini oluşturur. Zaman içinde makyajlı kadın ile makyajsız kadın belirsizce yer değiştirirken yapmak ile bozmanın belki de aynı şey olduğu düşüncesi ortaya çıkar.
